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# Directors of Psychological Health

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Assess Soldiers for deployability based on mental health symptoms and diagnosis.

Conduct DOD Central Adjudication Facility BH Security Clearance Evaluations

Assist in Case Management with Soldiers who are issued a profile, in a Medical board process or needs to enter into a Medical Board.

Conduct Position of Significant Trust and Authority Evaluations.

Provide individual counseling sessions.

Build relationships and collaborate with community partners in order to assist in identifying needs of Soldiers and Families and finding community resources.
