

Swanville Energy & Environment Planning Team Meeting 3
Rescheduled to 2/1/22, (originally scheduled for 1/12/2022)

The meeting started at 7:05 with introductions.

We reviewed the five topic areas comprising Energy & Environment: Storm Events, Water, Land & Food, Energy, and Waste, and introduced the meeting's primary targets of tonight's meeting, prioritizing the goals and action steps, and reviewing the results of the survey. This is the third out of four meetings.

At our last meeting we discussed Goals and Action Step Prioritization and established a set of decision-making criteria that we are using tonight to score our Goals and Action Steps. The criteria's are:

1. Supports City of Swanville vision to be a welcoming community to live, work, play and raise a family.
2. Supports City mission of saving time and/or money.
3. Able to accomplish.

Sandy, Norm and Tom individually prioritized the goals. Erica tabulated results.

A variety of projects were discussed, the following projects were

1. Energy Audits and implementing affordable action that saved the city money
2. Changing out light bulbs for city owned lights.
3. Having a location for hazardous waste, specifically for paint.
4. Planning trees on corridor – purchase a year in advance and plant to get them established, and then move them later after the development is done.
5. Host an Earth Day Event to showcase energy efficiency.

The funding was explained thoroughly and Erica will get information to Sandy about possible match funds from the Initiative Foundation to secure the full \$10k from Sourcewell.

The next meeting will be February 23rd 7-8:30pm, where we will review the draft plan, projects costs/benefits, and talk about next steps and project champions.

The final meeting will be on Wednesday 2/23/22.
